Dear friends and prayer partners, dear SU family,

A few days ago, I was listening to a radio program interviewing children on their perception of the future. Many of them expressed their anxiety because of Covid related issues, the war in Ukraine and the destruction of the environment. And we all know that a lot of adults are feeling the same way.

At the same time our society is reasonably optimistic that we will be able to manage in the end. If we try hard enough, we will be able to stop global warming and all related consequences. We will be able to stop wars and live together peacefully as one humankind. We will be able to live our normal lives forever. But is this what the Bible is telling us?

When I grew up in the 60s and 70s in a Christian family, sermons, and books on the 'end of times' were quite popular (and quite frightening to me as a child). However, in recent years I have heard very little about eschatological topics.

When Jesus talked about the end of times, he made it very clear that life on earth would become a lot worse before He would come back and make all things new. He wanted his disciples to be prepared – but even more, to have hope!

Hope conquers fear

Instead of being paralysed with fear and feeling powerless and overwhelmed, Jesus' disciples are invited to lift their heads and rise with courage and joy. Why? Because in God's timeline, the end is the beginning. His kingdom comes into full shape when our world ends. People who are trusting God's word are aware that the best is yet to come: a time when we finally will get rid of our imperfections, when we will finally be able to fully live out what God has created in us when we were born again. A time when pain, suffering and tears will finally end forever.

Is the end of the times really that near? Is the global pandemic, the war in Ukraine, the suffering environment a concrete sign of the end? I have no idea. But that's not important. God knows the dates and times. The important bit for us is to know, horribly bad and disturbing things will necessarily happen all over the world before Jesus returns. But they should never discourage us. On the contrary, we should take strength and hope because our Lord is coming soon!

Hope encourages ministry

If we are convinced that our salvation is coming, then it is natural to share our hope and invite as many people as possible into God's kingdom. In a daunting world, people of hope can make a difference by living out – even in a broken and fractured way – God's deep love. Let us pray for each other that we will be able to do this – whether in challenging environments, in a restricted country or during times of war. Our brothers and sisters all need our prayer support. Thank you for joining in.

We celebrate the life of John Jacob who passed away on 2 February this year. Born to Armenian parents in 1924 in colonial India, John received his schooling in St. Paul's School, Darjeeling where he was led to Christ by R. T. Archibald of Scripture Union. John was just 12 then; yet he wished to be an evangelist as Archibald was. And God made that happen when John turned 32.

While teaching in Hebron School, Ooty - a hill station in South India, John went to Scotland on holiday. Soon he joined SU Scotland as their Camps Organiser. In 1962, he returned to India and served SU, visiting English schools in south India. He led thousands of boys and girls to Christ and trained them in the SU Bible-reading system.

Between 1972 - 1986, John made a tremendous contribution as SU India's General Secretary and SU South Asia's Regional Secretary. The SU Camp Centre along the East Coast in Mamallapuram (near Chennai) was his brainchild. More than an administrator, John was truly an evangelist by heart. This caused him to work with children and young people even in his advanced years.

John loved people and developed lasting friendships with them, remembering them each by name in prayer regularly. A great man of God, known for his simplicity, courage, and practical advice! Thank God for the life of brother John Jacob!

□ Scripture Union International


A virtual Global Board meeting will be held today. Please pray as they prepare for the General Assembly that is due to held 1-4 July.
